Ellie Kendrick is a writer and performer across film, theatre and television. She is a graduate of the Channel 4 Screenwriting Course and has had several of her own original ideas commissioned for scripted development by the BBC and Channel 4. She was named a finalist for the Bruntwood Prize for Playwriting in 2016 with her first play, TABS, and a Jerwood New Playwright of 2018 for her next play HOLE, staged at the Royal Court in the same year. She trained as a playwright on the Royal Court Young Writers' Programme, Studio Group, and a special invitational group led by EV Crowe. She has also co-written an original standalone drama for BBC Radio 4 and a short film, SILLY GIRL, which premiered on Nowness. Ellie is represented as an actor by Claire Maroussas at Independent. She has performed in many roles across theatre, film and television, including Game of Thrones, Misfits, Being Human, The Levelling, An Education, and The Diary of Anne Frank and plays at the Royal Court, Globe and Hampstead theatres.
