Andrew's debut feature, the Paleolithic horror OUT OF DARKNESS was released in early 2024 to rave reviews and upon its US theatrical release became the most successful British debut for seven years. This year Andrew directed the opening block of SHETLAND Season 9 and three episodes of COLDWATER, a new darkly comic thriller for ITV and Sister Pictures written by David Ireland, starring Andrew Lincoln and Indira Varma. Previously, Andrew directed three episodes of PAYBACK for ITV and Jed Mercurio's HTM Productions, starring Morven Christie and Peter Mullan. Other TV credits include the acclaimed thriller CLIQUE for BBC / Balloon and COLD FEET for ITV / Big Talk.
