Nina has also written extensively for The Six Twenty's comedy/sketch show MIXTAPE, Live Theatre's Youth Theatre and she recently made her screenwriting debut with short fiction film Salt which was cowritten and screened as part of the NFTS Graduate Showcase 2019. As well as writing Nina has worked previously as both a director and dramaturg for stage and she also runs the creative writing course at Newcastle Theatre Royal.
