Poppy Damon is a screenwriter and journalist. Formerly the executive producer of The Times and The Sunday Times's daily news podcast, Poppy has reported from El Salvador, Costa Rica and the USA. Whilst at The Times, Poppy worked with veteran war reporter Anthony Loyd as the producer of The Last Man Standing- a series about his investigation into the kidnap of journalist John Cantlie in Syria. Whilst at the BBC Poppy worked as a producer and reporter for Radio 4 news programmes. Her two most recent podcast series for Audible were about a real 1920s crime that inspired Agatha Christie and the true story behind The Great Gatsby. Poppy now works as a screenwriter and producer in London and New York. Her recent credits include Karen Pirie (ITV). She won her place on the 2021 Brit List for her gripping and stylish gangster thriller feature titled: Let's Go Get Your F**king Dog Back. It is in development with Joi Productions.
