For theatre, she is under commission to The Yard Theatre, London, Teater Vestland, Norway and developing a play with the support of the National Theatre Studio. She is published by Faber. As a screenwriter, she is currently writing on the Bucanner/Paramount + The Crow Girl TV Series based on the novel by Erik Axl Sund, created by Milly Thomas. She is under commission to write original thriller feature films for Film 4/DNA, BBC Films /Wild Swim and ISB Films. She has previously written for and contributed to TV shows including GLUE (C4/Eleven, EP 5) THE CAPTURE (BBC, Writers Room), SNATCHES (BBC AMERICA).
