Sam Blair is a documentary filmmaker whose work is resolutely steered towards the cinema. A graduate of the UK's National Film and Television School, since making his BFI funded debut feature, Personal Best, Sam has consistently worked with the UK's most renowned documentary producers. In 2014 he directed Maradona '86, an ESPN 30 for 30, produced by John Battsek for Passion Pictures. Sam went on to work with Passion again on the feature documentary Keep Quiet which premiered in the International Competition at the Tribeca Film Festival. In 2016 he directed the first episode of Captive, a Netflix original documentary series, executive produced by Simon Chinn and Doug Liman.-
